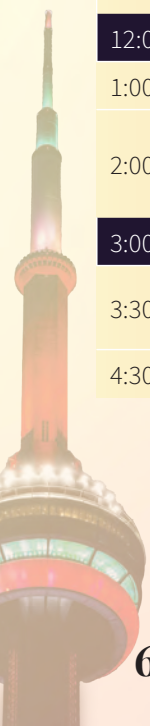

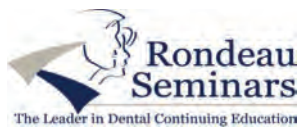

Why Occlusal Night Guards might be Detrimental to the Overall Health of your Patient

The majority of the dentists in North America were trained in dental school to place upper nightguards to stop the patient from wearing down their teeth due to clenching and grinding at night.

Research has shown that patients treated with the flat plane nightguard actually clench more and often wake up with headaches.

I prefer to fabricate the upper nightguard with only the lower incisors touching the anterior ramp and no posterior teeth touching. With no posterior contact, the patient can no longer clench. This nightguard has an incisal ramp to keep the lower jaw from falling back at night.

2. Understand the difference between intra-capsular issues (problems inside the TM joint) and extracapsular issues (problems outside the joint)

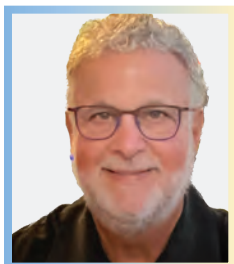

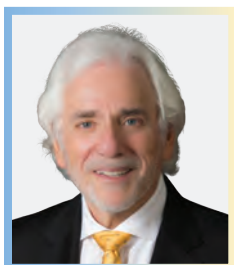

Progress and Innovations in the field of Dental Ceramics

Our laboratories present a very different face from those I knew when I started. The advent of digital technology has considerably changed the overall vision of our porcelain rehabilitations. Until now, aesthetic crowns in traditional ceramic, with low coverage thicknesses, seemed to be a challenge that was very often doomed to failure.

Over the past 7 years or so, new porcelain has emerged, in the form of pastes, and powders have become a thing of the past. With an extremely fine grain size, these paste porcelains have a strong covering power, which allows, even at very low thickness, to provide color, saturation and depth. With an aesthetic result that is more than satisfactory.

During my conference, by illustrating some clinical cases, I will present my way of using these ceramic pastes, the different applications and the many benefits. I will also present the new CADback software and its advantages.

Unlocking CDCP Success: Essential Updates and Expert Guidance for Denturists

The session will provide an extensive overview of the Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP). Hosted by The Denturist Association of Ontario (DAO), with Special Guests DAC President Jaro Wojcicki and DAC Executive Director Mallory Potter, it aims to update members on the latest developments and address the top questions received from denturists.

The introduction will emphasize the importance of the CDCP Dental Benefits Guide, which outlines the range of services covered as of May 1, 2024. These services will include standard complete dentures, repairs, relines, and more, with specific preauthorization requirements for certain procedures. There will be no annual spending limits, but frequency limits will apply to ensure proper utilization of benefits. If the information is available, we will also outline the expectations for November when all procedure codes under the program become available, i.e. those that require preauthorization.

The session will explain the co-payment and balanced billing responsibilities for patients based on their adjusted family net income. Detailed guidance on billing practices and patient payments will be provided to ensure clarity for providers. Coordination of benefits will be another critical topic, detailing how the CDCP complements existing dental benefits and coordinates with other social oral health programs. Procedures for billing according to the prescribed payer order of social programs will be outlined to avoid duplication of coverage.

The claims submission process will be thoroughly covered, highlighting the steps for submitting claims and verifying CDCP client eligibility. Providers will be reminded that claims can only be submitted once treatment is complete, with specific requirements for different types of services. Additionally, the session will address exclusions under the CDCP, such as precision equilibrated dentures and implant-related procedures, and provide guidance on fabricating and billing for standard dentures.

Updates on the CDCP Look-Up Tool and Provider Search will be discussed, noting improvements in the availability of procedure codes and the recent updates to the provider search tool. The claims processing and payment agreement segment will include feedback from members on the agreement and the claims verification program, clarifying documentation requirements for claims verification.

The session will also detail the eligibility and frequency limits for repair procedure codes and the preauthorization requirements for repairs involving multiple claim lines. Various miscellaneous questions will be addressed, including those related to fees, adjustment periods, eligibility for dentures, payment frequency, and implant-related coverage.

Resources provided during the session will include links to the CDCP Toolkit, Benefits Guide, Fee Grids, and additional information for oral health providers. Contact information will also be given for further support and queries. The session aims to equip denturists with the necessary updates and practical guidance to navigate the CDCP effectively, ensuring they can provide optimal care to their patients.

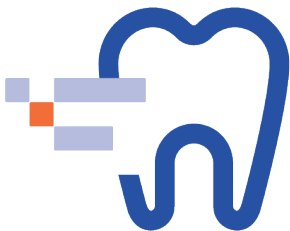

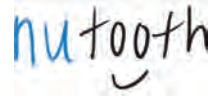

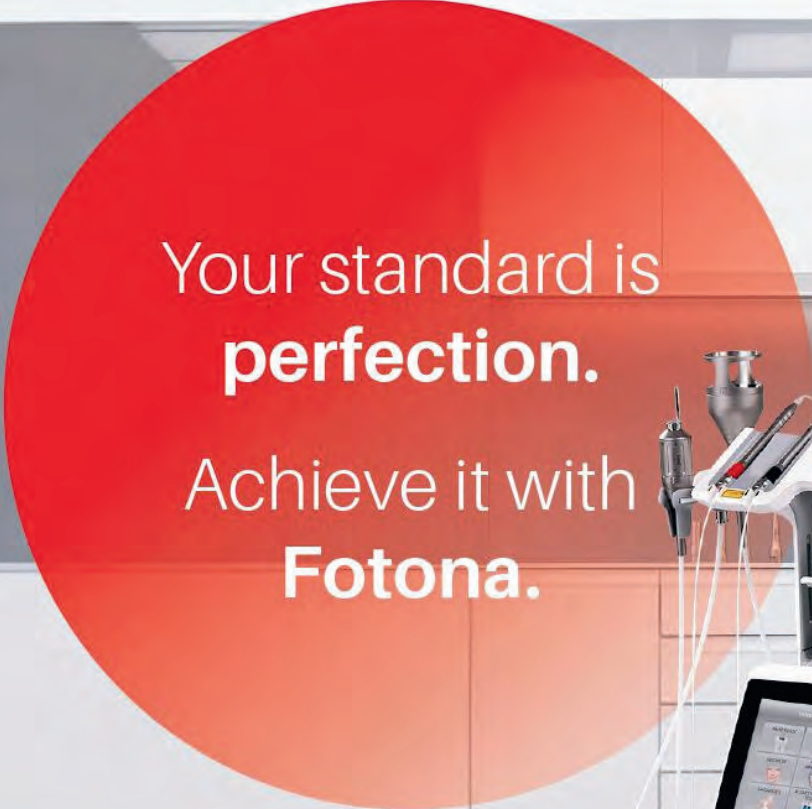
